## **Welcome to Visitors**

President Tepper welcomed members of the faculty, community, and press to the meeting. José Rivera led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Tepper asked if anyone wished to address the Board. No one responded. Members of the audience introduced themselves.

## **Administrative Reports**

## 5Cast Projection Presentation

Mr. Hitcho presented the five-year financial projections and reviewed the data used to create the projections. The majority of the revenue is generated by property taxes and other local revenue (89%), with 10% from other state revenue, and 1% from federal funding. The tax base assumption for 2023 is 5%. The majority of expenses is generated by salaries (53%) and benefits (12%). Other expenses include Purchased Services (20%), Supplies (8%), Capital Outlay (1%), and other objects (6%). The projections indicate a referendum could be necessary in the next five years. The last referendum was in 2006. At that time, a generation, which is nine years, of no referendum was promised. We have managed our finances and extended that promise almost twenty years.
