

Early Childhood Programs, Ages 3-5

The District 96 early childhood and special education programs offer a range of options. Instruction is provided at the Willow Grove Kindergarten & Early Childhood Center, 777 Checker Drive, Buffalo Grove.

The *Early Childhood Program* in District 96 serves children ages 3-5 years old (pre-Kindergarten). Each classroom has an Early Childhood Teacher with special education endorsement and an aide.

Speech & Language Services



Blended Early Childhood

Blended Early Childhood Classrooms include students 3-5 years old (pre-Kindergarten) with an Individualized Education Program (IEP), as well as community peers, whose families pay tuition for their child to attend the program.

In a Blended Early Childhood Classroom, approximately 30 percent of the students have an IEP; about 70 percent are community peers.

Instruction occurs primarily in groups — both large and small. The focus includes building skills to:

- follow Illinois Early Learning and Development Standards
- participate in group discussions (with minimal adult assistance):
- develop more mature attending skills;
- develop appropriate large-group behavior and social skills.

Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE)



Early Childhood Special Education Classrooms (ECSE) include students 3-5 years old (pre-Kindergarten) with an Individualized Education Program (IEP).

Class size is smaller than the Blended Early Childhood Classroom.

Instruction occurs individually and in groups. The focus includes building skills to:

- follow Illinois Early Learning and Development Standards
- build independence
- direct instruction in expected school routines

Structured Program



Structured Program Classrooms include students 3-5 years old (pre-Kindergarten) with an Individualized Education Program (IEP).

Class size is smaller than the Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) Classroom.

Services provided through a team approach to problem-solving include (but are not limited to) the following:

- grade-level academic skills
- functional academic skills
- communication skills
- social skills
- self-management skills
- independence skills
- decision-making skills
- recreation/leisure skills
